**Section 55 – National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949**  
**Pennine Bridleway National Trail:**  
**Varying Report No. 33 – Selside, Horton in Ribblesdale, Yorkshire Dales**

I am directed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to say that consideration has been given to Natural England's Varying Report No.33 proposing realignment of the Pennine Bridleway National Trail.

The effect of the variation order is described in the report. Briefly, the intention is to move the line of the way in order to improve safety by taking users off road as much as possible and away from the generally unsuitable B6479. The variation also avoids areas where ecological and archaeological features might be adversely affected by use as part of the Pennine Bridleway National Trail.

I have carefully considered the proposed variations and am satisfied that Natural England has carried out the appropriate consultations. I understand there are no objections to the proposals.

I hereby approve the proposals contained in Natural England's Varying Report No.33. I have written to North Yorkshire County Council, Craven District Council and the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority to notify them of the Secretary of State's approval.
